
### ELIGIBILITY/SELECTION CRITERIA FOR NOMINEES

1. The nominee must be a member in good standing of OSPE and a volunteer (including Board Directors and Officers) who has contributed beyond the expected level of effort by serving as an advocate for the engineering community, particularly engineering students and young professionals, through various roles during academic studies and immediately following graduation.
2. The award may be given annually to an engineering student or engineering graduate up to 5 years following graduation.
3. The nominee must have demonstrated well above the expected efforts as a volunteer for a period of at least 2 years.


4. Please describe the scope of the nominee's achievement and the work undertaken for at least 2 years in the following areas (please limit all responses to a maximum of 300 words):
